Developed detailed shoot reports and resolved impediments, including recasting actors and troubleshooting equipment malfunctions, while keeping film on its planned timeline.

- Editor for *Bored Games*, a 7-minute buddy comedy about two friends that are stuck indoors on a rainy day looking for ways to pass the time, when an unlikely source of entertainment draws division between them. Completing the film was met with many challenges as shooting the film took 22 hours and editing took another 10 hours. Organized all the footage and audio to efficiently complete the set deadline.
- Partnered with the Director, Cinematographer, and production teams to maintain the integrity of the story, checked with audio, and shaped the film's comedic atmosphere. Authored and submitted official credits to IMDb, solidifying the film's legitimacy and contributing to it making Semi-finals in the 48 Hour Festival.
