## THE OPPORTUNITY



The average film crew creates 100 lbs of compost waste daily (from food prep and scraps), not even including leftover food for donations! For the Netflix Fort Monmouth campus, which includes on-site dining, retail, and food service operations, this could result in close to **1 ton of compost daily**. If this were placed in landfill, it would generate nearly **1,400 tons of methane emissions each year**, further contributing to the climate crisis.

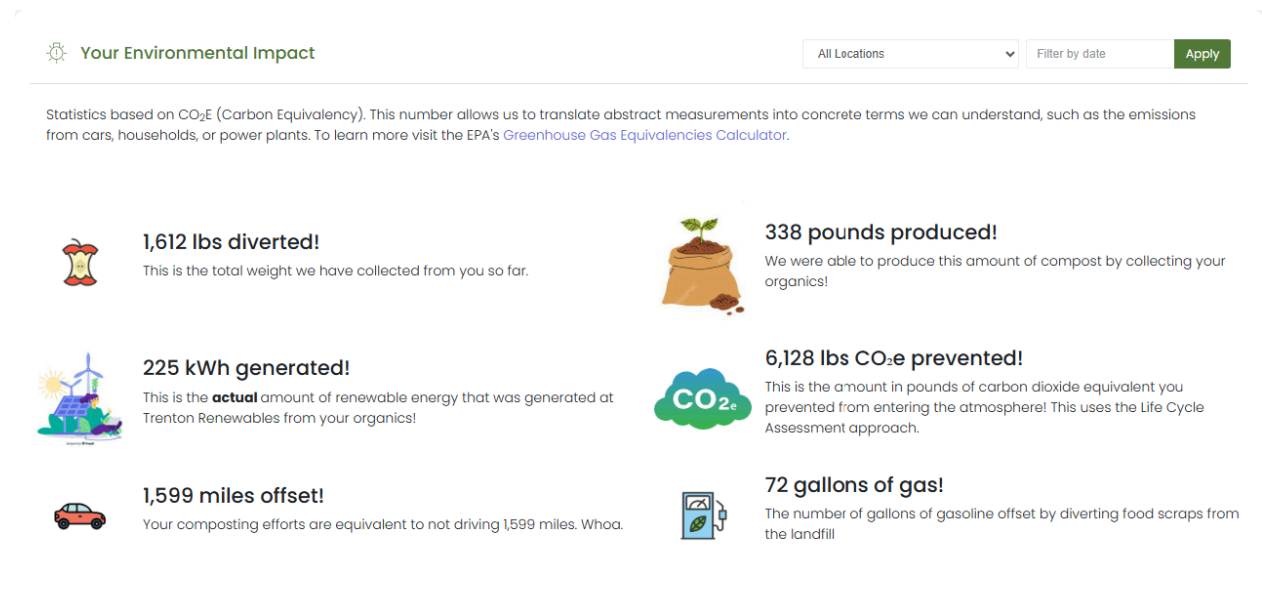
